

NATIONAL PARKS ROAD TRIP




DAY 1 & 2

Arrive in SF and explore Union Square, Chinatown and the famous Painted Ladies on Alamo Square are only a few of the landmarks on the itinerary. Stroll around the Fisherman's Wharf area with its many attractions, such as Pier 39, the Bay Aquarium and the Wax Museum.

DAY 3 *3¼ hour drive to Yosemite National Park*

Yosemite is internationally recognized for its granite cliffs, waterfalls, clear streams, giant sequoia groves, impressive lakes, grandiose mountains, glaciers, and biological diversity.

DAY 4 *4 hour drive to Lake Tahoe*

Lake Tahoe straddles the state line of California and Nevada with the bragging rights as one of the world's largest alpine lakes.

DAY 5 & 6

Medford. Today is full of historical towns, culinary experiences and thrilling river excursion. Start your morning with a tour of the world's famous, Harry and David facility. Then just a short 10 minute drive to the quaint town of Jacksonville where the entire downtown area is on the historic registry. Take a historic trolley ride through town and shop, on your own, at boutique stores, award winning restaurants, antique stores, and wine tasting rooms. Head to the Artisan Corridor: Rogue Creamery (WORLD'S BEST CHEESE), Lillie Belle Farms (handcrated truffles), and Ledger David Cellars (one of 53 tasting rooms in the Rogue Valley). Now head to Rogue Jet Boat Adventures ,Oregon's top cultural and historical attraction. Rogue Jet Boat Adventures is passionate about sharing the native American historical message of the Table Rock area and combining that message with thrilling jet boating.

Tonight enjoy a dinner at one of Medford's downtown's farm to table restaurant experiences or a wine and dine experience at DANCIN Vineyards.



DAY 7 *1¼ hour drive to Crater Lake National Park*

Get an early morning start and head out for an incredible adventure. You will travel to Oregon's only national park, Crater Lake National Park. Established in 1902, Crater Lake is the fifth-oldest park in the United States and the deepest lake (1,949 feet deep) in the nation. The impressive average depth of this volcanic lake is due to the nearly symmetrical 4,000 foot-deep caldera formed 7,700 years ago during the violent climatic eruptions and subsequent collapse of Mount Mazama.

Take a boat ride around the lake, hike a number of scenic trails, shop at one of two gift stores, take an interpretive tour, and/or enjoy a trolley ride around the rim. Lunch at the grand Crater Lake Lodge is incredible with views overlooking the Lake.

After Lunch head along the scenic Hwy 138 where you will follow the North Umpqua River and find over 13 waterfalls spotting your journey.

Pass through the town of Roseburg and follow the South Umpqua River along Hwy 42 W to Bandon by the Sea.

Bandon *3½ hours from Crater Lake National Park*

This small fishing tourism town makes for a great stop with year round fishing, cycling, golf (Home of Bandon Dunes), hiking and miles of open beach combing. Inn at Facerock is a great location to enjoy dinner, stay the night, and take a sunset beach stroll. Overnight in Bandon

DAY 8 *3½ hour drive to Eureka, CA*

Take the morning to enjoy shopping in the historic downtown area of Bandon. Or beach combing ... or horseback ride along the beach.

Get on the Road and travel through the world largest trees, the redwoods. Nearly half of the remaining old growth redwoods are in this park system, including giants five stories taller than the Statue of Liberty. They can live to be 2000 years old and grow over 360 feet tall.

Next stop Trees of Mystery. Another hour down the road, located in the heart of the Redwood Empire, is the very center of Redwood National and State Park. Trees of Mystery is California's premier nature attraction on the North Coast. Take the sky rail, see Paul Bunyan, visit the museum, hike the trails ... all in an afternoon. Welcome to the California redwoods. You will be overnighing 30 minutes from Trees of Mystery in Eureka., CA. Overnight in Eureka, CA
