






A VOYAGE TO CRISP VIOGNIER

Viognier, the white jewel of Southern Oregon, requires a long, warm season. In contrast to Chardonnay, the Viognier varietal has more natural aromatics that include notes of peach, pears and violets. Clear your calendar for a day of Viognier wine tasting.
